1 Name of Policy

This Policy is *State Environmental Planning Policy (Transport and Infrastructure) Amendment (Bee Keeping and Grazing) 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Policy commences on 9 November 2022.

3 Repeal of Policy

This Policy is repealed at the beginning of the day following the day on which this Policy commences.

Division 9 Bee keeping and grazing

2.58A Definitions

In this Division—

bee keeping has the same meaning as in the Standard Instrument.

forest permit has the same meaning as in the *Forestry Act 2012*.

grazing means grazing of cattle or other livestock.

2.58B Development permitted without consent

Development for the purpose of bee keeping or grazing may be carried out without consent on land dedicated as State forest under the *Forestry Act 2012*, section 14 if—

- (a) for bee keeping—a forest permit in force immediately before 9 November 2022 permitted bee keeping on the land, or
- (b) for grazing—a forest permit in force immediately before 9 November 2022 permitted grazing on the land, or
- (c) the land is in 1 or more of the following zones—
 - (i) RU1 Primary Production,
 - (ii) RU2 Rural Landscape,
 - (iii) RU3 Forestry.
