PUISNE JUDGE.

An Act to authorise the appointing of an Additional Judge in the Supreme Court of New South Wales. [17th August, 1825.]

Preamble.

The Governor
empowered to
appoint an additional
Judge of the Supreme
Court until His
Majesty's pleasure
be known.

WHEREAS it is necessary that provision be made without delay for the appointment of an additional Judge in the Supreme Court of New South Wales Now therefore be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of the said Colony with the advice of the Council That it shall be lawful for the said Governor by Commission under the Great Seal of the said Colony to appoint some fit and proper person to be an additional Judge of the said Court until His Majesty's pleasure shall be made known and the said additional Judge shall exercise such his office either without or in conjunction with the Chief Justice of the said Court and shall have and exercise all the jurisdictions powers and authorities belonging to or vested in the said Chief Justice.
