An Act for continuing until the first day of September one thousand eight hundred and forty-five an Act of the Governor and Council of New South Wales made and passed in the fifth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria and intituled “*An Act to facilitate proceedings by and against the proprietors of a certain Joint Stock Company lately carrying on business in Sydney in the Colony of New South Wales under the name style or firm of the Australian Auction Company and for other purposes therein mentioned.*” [31st August, 1843.]

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the fifth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria intituled “*An Act to facilitate proceedings by and against the proprietors of a certain Joint Stock Company lately carrying on business in Sydney in the Colony of New South Wales under the name style or firm of the Australian Auction Company and for other purposes therein mentioned*” it was amongst other things enacted that the said Act should commence and take effect from and after the passing thereof and should continue in force for two years thereafter and not longer save and except as to any action suit prosecution or other proceeding at law or in equity actually commenced or instituted which notwithstanding the said Act should have expired might be carried on in all respects whatsoever as if the same had continued in force and whereas it is expedient that the duration of the said Act should be extended Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That the said Act shall be extended and continue in force until the first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-five.
