time to time by the Speaker of the Legislative Council of the said
Colony in pursuance of any Resolutions of the Committee of Correspondence of the said Council Be it enacted by His Excellency the Honorable Francis
Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Scott to be Agent
for the Colony.
