An Act to continue an Act intituled "An Act to Party Processions.

" prevent for a limited time Party Processions and " certain other public exhibitions in the Colony of

" New South Wales." [20th July, 1849.]

WHEREAS by an Act passed by the Governor and Legislative Preamble. Council of New South Wales in the tenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria intituled "An Act to prevent for a limited 10 Vic. No. 1" time Party Processions and certain other public exhibitions in the "Colony of New South Wales" it was amongst other things enacted that the said Act should commence and take effect from and after the passing thereof and should thenceforward continue in force for three years but no longer And whereas it is expedient that the duration of the said Act should be extended Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That the duration of the said continued until 31st Act shall be extended and that the same shall continue in force until December 1855. the thirty-first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five.
