APPROPRIATION  
(1850).

An Act for applying certain Sums arising from the Revenue receivable in New South Wales to the Service thereof for the Year One thousand eight hundred and fifty and for further appropriating the said Revenue. [9th October, 1849.]

Preamble.

5 and 6 Vic. c. 76.

WHEREAS by a certain Act of Parliament passed in the fifth and sixth year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria intituled "*An Act for the Government of New South Wales and Van Diemen's Land*" it was among other things enacted that the Governor of the said Colony of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council should have authority to make laws for the peace welfare and good government of the said Colony and that with the deductions and subject to the provisions therein contained the whole of Her Majesty's Revenue within the said Colony arising from taxes duties rates and imposts levied on Her Majesty's subjects within the said Colony should be appropriated to the public service within the said Colony by Ordinances to be for that purpose enacted by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of the said Colony and in no other manner Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That out of the produce of the said taxes duties rates and imposts there shall and may be issued and applied any sum or sums of money not exceeding twenty-eight thousand nine hundred and seventy-six pounds six shillings and eleven-pence to defray the salaries allowances and contingencies of the Civil Establishments of the said Colony unprovided for by Schedule B of the said recited Act of Parliament for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty as hereinafter more particularly expressed that is to say any sum or sums of money not exceeding six hundred and thirty-five pounds six shillings and three-pence to defray the salaries allowances and contingencies of His Excellency the Governor's Establishment and any sum or sums of money not exceeding three thousand seven hundred and sixteen pounds five shilling and four-pence to defray the salaries allowances and contingencies of the Legislative Council Establishment and any sum

Kennedy and any sum or sums of money not exceeding seven hundred and ninety-four pounds six shillings and six-pence in aid of the Sydney Infirmary and Dispensary an equal amount having been raised by private contribution in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight and any sum or sums of money not exceeding one hundred pounds in aid of the Experimental Silk Institution Sydney on condition of an equal amount being raised by private contribution and any sum or sums of money not exceeding one hundred and fifty pounds to meet the expense of additional Compositors and Pressmen in the Government Printing Establishment Sydney and any sum or sums of money not exceeding the further sum of one hundred and seventy pounds two shillings to defray the expense of additional Oil for Cape Otway Light Port Phillip and any sum or sums of money not exceeding thirty pounds to defray the salary of the Secretary to the Denominational School Board Port Phillip for the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine and any sum or sums of money not exceeding the further sum of three thousand pounds towards completing Prince's Bridge Port Phillip and any sum or sums of money not exceeding two hundred and eighty pounds to defray the expense of additional Foundations for the Light-house on Gellibrand's Point Port Phillip and any sum or sums of money not exceeding one hundred pounds as additional remuneration to the Overseer of the Works on Cape Otway Light-house Port Phillip and any sum or sums of money not exceeding three thousand three hundred and fifty-two pounds nineteen shillings and eight-pence to meet the deficiency in the amount voted for the erection of Light-houses in Bass's Straits and any sum or sums of money not exceeding the further sum of thirty pounds for providing a Clock for the Post Office Melbourne Port Phillip and any sum or sums of money not exceeding two hundred pounds as a Donation in aid of the Geelong Mechanics' Institution and any sum or sums of money not exceeding the further sum of two hundred pounds towards the maintenance of the Melbourne Hospital on condition of an equal sum being raised by private contribution and any sum or sums of money not exceeding twenty pounds as remuneration to the Clerk of the Returning Officer for compiling the Electoral Lists Port Phillip for the year one thousand eight hundred and forty eight and nine.

24. And be it enacted That the Treasurer of the said Colony shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him shall from time to time order and direct and that the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Revenues of the said Colony.

25. And be it enacted That the said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid and that the receipt or receipts of the respective persons

to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be therein mentioned and that he shall and do receive credit for the same accordingly.
