Governor

HEREAS by a certain Act of Parliament passed in the fifth and sixth year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria intituled "An Act for the Government of New South Wales and Van Diemen's Land" it was among other things enacted that the Governor of the said Colony of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council should have authority to make laws for the peace welfare and good government of the said Colony and that with the deductions and subject to the provisions therein contained the whole of Her Majesty's Revenue within the said Colony arising from taxes duties rates and imposts levied on Her Majesty's subjects within the said Colony should be appropriated to the public service within the said Colony by Ordinances to be for that purpose enacted by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of the said Colony and in no other manner Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That out of the produce of the said taxes duties rates and imposts there shall and may be issued and applied any sum or sums of money not exceeding twenty-eight thousand nine hundred and seventy-six pounds six shillings and eleven-pence to defray the salaries allowances and contingencies of the Civil Establishments of the said Colony unprovided for by Schedule B of the said recited Act of Parliament for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty as hereinafter more particularly expressed that is to say any sum or sums of money not exceeding six hundred and thirty-five pounds six shillings and threepence to defray the salaries allowances and contingencies of His Legislative Council Excellency the Governor's Establishment and any sum or sums of money not exceeding three thousand seven hundred and sixteen pounds five shilling and four-pence to defray the salaries allowances and contingencies of the Legislative Council Establishment and any
