## No. XXVI.

An Act for applying certain Sums arising from the Revenue receivable in New South Wales to the Service thereof for the Year One thousand eight hundred and fifty-one and for further appropriating the said Revenue. [1st October, 1850.]

wHEREAS by a certain Act of Parliament passed in the fifth and sixth year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen
