An Act to exempt the Sale of Books and other PRINTED BOOKS &c.
Publications from the provisions of the Act FREE SALE.
relating to Hawkers and Pedlers. [27th July,
1852.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to exempt from the provisions of the Preamble.
Act of Council passed in the thirteenth year of the reign of
Her present Majesty and numbered thirty-six the sale of all Printed
Books and other such Publications as hereinafter mentioned within
the Colony of New South Wales Be it therefore enacted by His
Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and
consent of the Legislative Council thereof That from and after the
passing of this Act the selling or offering for sale any Printed Books Sales of Books
Pamphlets Periodicals or other Printed Publications shall be exempted Pamphlets &c.
from the provisions of the said Act in the same manner as if the same exempted from the
had been expressly included within the proviso or exemption contained provisions of 13 Vic.
in the twenty-third section of the said Act. No. 36.
