An Act to enable the Government to open a Road from the Parramatta Road to the Public Abattoir now being erected on Glebe Island and to prevent Cattle from being driven on such Road except within certain hours. [7th September, 1855.]

ABATTOIR ROAD.

WHEREAS the Public Abattoir mentioned in the Act of Council of the fourteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria number thirty-six is in the course of erection on Glebe Island in Johnson's Bay near the City of Sydney and is expected to be shortly completed and it is necessary to open a road upon which animals intended for slaughter thereat may be driven thereto from the highway known as the Parramatta Road And whereas it is fitting that the driving of cattle on such road should be restricted to certain hours Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Preamble.

14 Vic. No. 36.

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council to cause to be opened and made a road of the width of one chain from and out of the Parramatta Road to the shore of Johnson's Bay in the direction and through the lands mentioned on the Schedule hereto or as near thereto as may be found most convenient and to cause to be made a causeway or bridge from the termination of the said road to Glebe Island aforesaid.

Road may be opened from Parramatta Road to Glebe Island.

2. Provided that before any cattle shall be permitted to be driven along the said road the same shall at the public expense be well and securely fenced in on both sides thereof with a three-railed hardwood fence.

Road to be securely fenced at public expense.

3. Provided also that no bull cow ox heifer or steer except milch cows or working cattle (in teams or otherwise) shall be driven along the said road except between the hours of six o'clock in the evening and eight o'clock in the morning and every person who shall drive or cause to be driven any such cattle into or along the said road at any other time shall on conviction before one or more Justices of the Peace forfeit and pay any sum not exceeding twenty shillings for each and every head of such cattle so driven.

Cattle to be driven on the road only between 6 P.M. and 8 A.M.

4. If any proprietor or occupier of any land through which such intended road shall pass and for the making of which through such land no general or other power of making such road was reserved in the original grant thereof shall deem himself aggrieved thereby he shall be entitled to compensation for the damage (if any) he shall sustain by the opening of the said road and such compensation shall be ascertained upon the like notice and by the like means as are required and provided by the Act of Council passed in the fourth year of the reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth number eleven Provided always that this enactment shall not apply to such proprietors and occupiers as have already consented to the opening of the said road on conditions corresponding with the provisoes contained in the second and third sections hereof.

Compensation to proprietors and occupiers injured by making the road.
