An Act for applying certain Sums to be raised by Loans. [18th December, 1855.]

PUBLIC LOANS

THEREAS by the Act of the Governor and Legislative Council of Preamble. New South Wales passed in the present Session intituled "An 19 Vic. No. 25. "Act to provide Funds by means of a Tonnage Duty for making "Improvements to the Navigation of the River Hunter and to the " Ports of Newcastle and Morpeth" the Government was authorized to borrow such sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of forty thousand pounds as should be from time to time required for making such Improvements And whereas by another Act passed in the present Session intituled "An Act to authorize the raising of Loans 19 Vic. "for Public Works on the security of the Consolidated Revenues of the "Colony And to remove doubts as to the security of former Loans" the Government was authorized to borrow a sum of money not exceeding three hundred and twenty-five thousand three hundred and twentythree pounds for the several purposes therein expressed And whereas it is expedient to enable the Government to proceed forthwith to the execution of the Improvements and Public Works referred to in the above recited Acts Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—
