An Act to authorize the execution of certain Public Loans. Public Works of a permanent character by means of Loans secured on the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony. [18th March, 1857.

HEREAS it is expedient to enable the Government to proceed Preamble. forthwith to the execution of certain Public Works And whereas by reason of such works being of a permanent character it is deemed expedient to provide the necessary funds for executing the same by means of Loans secured upon the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Governor and Execu-Executive Council from time to time to raise by the sale of Debentures time Council may raise sums of money (or otherwise) secured upon the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the secured upon the Colony and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding five pounds per Consolidated Revenue bearing centum per annum any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the interest at a rate not whole the sum of one hundred and seven thousand seven hundred and exceeding 5 per cent. per annum to the seventeen pounds eighteen shillings and eleven-pence sterling as may extent of be required for the several purposes hereinafter more particularly £107,717 18s, 11d. expressed that is to say:—

All sums borrowed under this Act shall be paid to the paid to the Treasurer of the said Colony to be applied to the several purposes for several purposes for which the same shall have been raised and the accounts of the sums which the same have expended on the said Improvements and Public Works and of the sums borrowed for the purposes thereof shall annually be laid before the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of the Colony and shall be examinable in the same manner as if the sums so expended and the sums so raised had formed part of the Current Annual Expenditure and Revenue of the Colony Provided that in the event of the erection of Moreton Bay into a separate Colony the sums of money hereinbefore authorized to be raised for Public Works in that District shall be chargeable to such new Colony.
