 lative Assembly of New South Wales in this present Parliament  
 assembled and by the authority of the same That the Act of Council  
 ten Victoria number one passed *“ To prevent for a limited time Party  
 “ Procections and certain other Public Exhibitions in the Colony of  
 “ New South Wales”* shall be and the same is hereby revived and  
 made perpetual.
