An Act to enable the Government to raise a a certain Loan to meet Debentures falling [22nd February, 1860.] due in 1860.

Public Loan.

HEREAS it is expedient to enable the Government to borrow Preamble. the sum of three hundred and sixty-five thousand six hundred pounds to pay off certain Debentures which will fall due in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :-

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Loans of £365,600 Executive Council to raise by the sale of Debentures secured upon the authorized to pay off Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colory and bearing interest. Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding five per centum per annum such sum or sums of money not exceeding three hundred and sixty-five thousand six hundred pounds in the whole as may be required to pay off and discharge certain Debentures which will fall due in one thousand eight hundred and sixty hereinafter more particularly specified that is to say-

Railway Debentures... £281,700Public Works Debentures 21,000 Sydney Sewerage Debentures 44,900 18,000 Sydney Water Works Debentures ...

2. All sums borrowed under this Act shall be paid to the sums borrowed how Colonial Treasurer and shall be by him placed to the credit of the to be accounted for. Consolidated Revenue Fund and shall be applied towards the purposes for which the same shall have been respectively raised and shall be accounted for in the same manner as if they had formed part of the Current Annual Revenue of the Colony.

3. All sums so as aforesaid borrowed and applied to paying off Act 20 Vic. No. 36 any Debentures for Sydney Sewerage or Water shall together with all s. 74 extended to this Act. interest thereon be and continue to be secured on the entire Revenues of the Council of the City of Sydney from whatever source arising.
