## No. VIII.

An Act to declare the law relative to Addi-Additional Conditional Conditional Purchases in certain Declaratory. cases. [22nd July, 1884.]

WHEREAS doubts have arisen on the construction of the "Crown Preamble. Lands Alienation Act of 1861" and the "Lands Acts Amendment Act 1875" whether after the commencement of the lastmentioned Act the right to make additional conditional purchases of Crown Lands was limited to conditional purchases of Crown Lands not exceeding two hundred and eighty acres and their legal aliences and to holders in fee-simple of lands granted by the Crown not exceeding the aforesaid area and it is expedient to remove such doubts therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—
