PARLIAMENTARY
ELECTORATES AND
ELECTIONS ACT
AMENDMENT.

An Act to amend sections 32 and 47 of the
Parliamentary Electorates and Elections
Act of 1893. [4th December, 1893.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Amendment of
section 32 of Parlia-
mentary Electorates
and Elections Act of
1893.

1. (I) The proviso to subsection (I), section thirty-two of the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act of 1893, is hereby amended by inserting the words "eight months" in place of the words "seven months" in that proviso.

Amendment of
section 47.

(II) Subsection (II) of the same section is hereby repealed.
2. Subsection (III) of section forty-seven of the above-mentioned Act is hereby amended by inserting the word "March" in place of the word "October" in that subsection.

Incorporation of Act
amended.

3. This Act shall be construed as one with the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act of 1893.
