Act No. 37, 1900.

An Act to provide that the expression "noxious PASTURES AND STOCK PROTECTION OF THE PROPERTY O animals" in the Pastures and Stock Protection Act, 1898, shall include rabbits. [23rd October, 1900.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Logislative Co. Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Pastures and Stock Protection Short title. (Rabbit) Act, 1900."
- 2. The expression "noxious animals" in the Pastures and Stock Noxious animals to Protection Act, 1898, shall include rabbits.
- 3. Nothing in this Act shall interfere with or derogate from Not to affect Rabbit the provisions of the Rabbit Act of 1890.
