Act No. 2, 1902.

An Act to sanction the erection of two pavilions in connection with Prince Alfred Hospital, Sydney; and for other purposes. [15th January, 1902.]

Prince Alfred Hospital Additions,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Public Proamble. Works Act, 1900, the Legislative Assembly did, by resolution, declare that it was expedient to carry out a certain work, namely, the erection of two pavilions in connection with Prince Alfred Hospital,

Prince Alfred Hospital Additions.

Sydney: And whereas on the passing of the said resolution a statutory duty was by the said Act imposed on the Secretary for Public Works to introduce a Bill into the said Assembly to sanction the carrying out of the said work: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Prince Alfred Hospital Additions Act, 1901."

Work sanctioned.

2. The carrying out of the said work (more particularly described in the Schedule to this Act) is hereby sanctioned; and the Sccretary for Public Works, or the member of the Executive Council for the time being performing the duties of the said Secretary, is hereby authorised to undertake and carry out the said work, subject to the provisions of this Act, and for that purpose shall be, and shall have the powers and duties of, a Constructing Authority, within the meaning of the Public Works Act, 1900.

Plan of work.

3. The plan of the said work is the plan marked "Prince Alfred Hospital Proposed Queen Victoria Memorial Pavilions," signed by the Secretary for Public Works, and countersigned by the Government Architect, and deposited in the public office of the said Secretary.

Cost, how to be defrayed.

4. The cost of carrying out the said work, estimated at forty-five thousand pounds, may be defrayed from such Loan Votes as are now or may hereafter be applicable to that purpose, and shall not under any circumstances exceed the estimated cost by more than ten per centum.

SCHEDULE.

The erection of buildings as follows:—Two pavilions on the north and south sides respectively of and connected with the existing Administrative block, containing wards for patients and administrative rooms in connection therewith, operating theatres with necessary adjuncts, clinical lecture rooms, accommodation for outdoor patients' department, medical baths and photographic department, stores, &c. Subject to such alterations as may be deemed necessary during the progress of the work.
