An Act to amend the Pastures Protection Act, 1902, in certain particulars. [7th December, 1904.]

PASTURES
PROTECTION
AMENDMENT.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “ Pastures Protection Amendment Act, 1904.” Short title.

2. Section forty-nine of the Pastures Protection Act, 1902, is hereby amended by the omission of the words “ to the satisfaction of the board ” and the substitution therefor of the following words “ in accordance with the requirements of the board as specified under the provisions of section fifty-two of the said Act.” Amendment of section 49.
