> BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Audit (Amendment) Act, 1918."

Amendment of Principal

2. Subsection one of section thirty-three of the of Principal Audit Act, 1902, is amended by omitting in parasec, 33(1)(a), graph (a) of that subsection the word "month", and inserting in lieu thereof the words "three months."
