Act No. 20, 1918.

An Act to amend the Prisons Act, 1899.

[Assented to, 29th August, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, **George V,**

Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—
