

PUBLICATION OF STATUTORY
ADVERTISEMENTS AND
NOTICES ACT.

Act No. 32, 1920.

George V, No. 32. An Act to amend the law relating to the publication in the Gazette and other newspapers of statutory advertisements and notices; to amend certain Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Publication of Statutory Advertisements and Notices Act, 1920."

Publication of statutory advertisements and notices.

2. Where any Act directs the publication of any advertisement or notice in the Gazette and in any newspaper or newspapers, it shall be a sufficient compliance with such direction if, in addition to such publication in the Gazette, there is also published in such newspaper or newspapers either a summary of such advertisement or notice or a statement only that such advertisement or notice has been published in the Gazette: Provided that the date of the Gazette in which such advertisement or notice has been published shall be specified in such summary or statement.
