PARLIAMENTARY SELECT COMMITTEES ENABLING ACT.

Act No. 35, 1923.

An Act to enable certain Parliamentary Select George V, Committees to sit during the adjournment or prorogation of Parliament; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 21st December, 1923.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

■ 1. This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Short title. Select Committees Enabling Act, 1923."

Certain Select Committees may sit, &c., during adjournment or prorogation of Parliament.

2. It is hereby declared that the Parliamentary Select Committees mentioned in the Schedule may lawfully sit during the period for which Parliament stands adjourned or prorogued, and do all such things as they may lawfully do while Parliament is in session.
