PARRAMATTA RIVER (SUTHERLAND STREET, AUBURN) BRIDGE ACT.

Act No. 43, 1930.

An Act to sanction the construction of a Bridge George v. across the Parramatta River at Sutherland-No. 43, 1930. street, Auburn; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 25th June, 1930.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the "Parramatta River short title. (Sutherland-street, Auburn) Bridge Act, 1930."

2. The carrying out of the works described in the Works Schedule is hereby sanctioned, and the Minister for Public Works is empowered to carry out the said works.

3. The plan of the said works is the plan marked "Parramatta River (Sutherland-street, Auburn) Bridge," signed by the said Minister, countersigned by the Director of Public Works, and deposited in the public office of the said Minister.

Estimated cost.

4. The cost of carrying out the said works (exclusive of land resumptions) is estimated at fifty-four thousand pounds, and such estimated cost shall not under any circumstances be exceeded by more than ten per centum.

SCHEDULE.

A BRIDGE over the Parramatta River at Sutherland-street, Auburn, consisting of nine timber beam spans, three 92 ft. composite truss spans and one 110 feet steel opening span, 691 feet in length over all, and 18 feet between kerbs with one 5 feet footway. Together with embanked approaches on both sides of the river. Subject to such deviations and modifications as may be considered desirable by the Constructing Authority.
