Act No. 47, 1931.

An Act to vest in the Crown certain lands situate at Parnell Place, Newcastle. [Assented to, 7th October, 1931.] George V.  
No. 47, 1931.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Parnell Place, Newcastle, Act, 1931." Short title.

**2.** The land described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby vested in His Majesty. Vesting in  
Crown as  
Crown lands.

The land shall be deemed to be land temporarily reserved from sale and lease under the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, and may on revocation of the reserve be dealt with and disposed of in accordance with the provisions of that Act.

## SCHEDULE.

Sec. 2.

ALL that piece or parcel of land situate in the City of Newcastle, parish of Newcastle, county of Northumberland, and State of New South Wales, being the whole of 35 perches and part of two roods 19 perches appropriated for tramway purposes by Gazette of 24th February, 1903:—

Commencing on the south-western side of Scott-street at the northernmost corner of the said 35 perches appropriated by Gazette of 24th February, 1903, and bounded thence on the north-east by that side of that street bearing 110 degrees 51 minutes 3 chains 4·5 links; on the east generally by the generally western boundary of 5½ perches described in Deed Register Book 865, No. 780, being one chain 73·7 links of an arc of a circle having a radius of 50 feet, with the centre lying to the west of the chord bearing 176 degrees 33 minutes for a distance of one chain 38·1 links; on the south-east by the north-western side of Beach Drive, being lines successively bearing 242 degrees 15 minutes 39·7 links and 244 degrees 49 minutes 2 chains 84·7 links; and on the west by the western boundary of the aforesaid 35 perches and 2 roods 19 perches appropriated by Gazette of 24th February, 1903, bearing 360 degrees 3 chains 86·3 links to the point of commencement, having an area of 3 roods 8½ perches or thereabouts.
