**Public Service Salaries (Further Amendment)

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Salaries (Further Amendment) Act, 1932."

Amendment of Act No. 29, 1931. 2. The Public Service Salaries Act, 1931-1932, is amended as follows:—

Sec. 4.
(Deduction from salaries.)

(a) (i) by omitting from paragraph (i) of the proviso to subsection one of section four the words "one hundred and ninety-seven" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one hundred and sixty-eight";

(ii) by omitting from paragraph (ii) of the same proviso the words "one hundred and seven" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "ninety-two";

(b) (i) by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection two of the same section the words "three hundred" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "two hundred and sixty-eight";

(ii) (a) by omitting from paragraph (b) of the same subsection the words "three hundred" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "two hundred and sixty-eight";

(b) by omitting from the same paragraph the words "below two hundred and sixty-eight" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "below two hundred and forty-one";

(c) by inserting in subsection two of section four after the word "widower" the words "or a divorced person" and after the word "widow" the words "or a divorced person."
