PUBLIC HOSPITALS (AMEND-MENT) ACT.

Act No. 23, 1933.

An Act to make further provision relating to George v, acting members and acting chairmen of the No. 23, 1933. Hospitals Commission of New South Wales; to amend the Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1932, in certain respects and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 20th December, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Hospitals Short title, (Amendment) Act, 1933," and shall be read with the and commencement. Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1932.

- (2) The Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1932, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1933.
- (3) This Act shall commence upon the twentysecond day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.
- 2. (1) The term of office as acting chairman of the Extension Hospitals Commission of New South Wales of Major of term of office of the Honorable Arthur Edmund Colvin, Member of the acting chair-Legislative Council, is hereby extended to and shall ex-man and acting pire upon the thirty-first day of July, one thousand nine member. hundred and thirty-four.

(2) The said Arthur Edmund Colvin, Esquire, shall not be entitled to receive any remuneration or emolument whether by way of salary or fees or otherwise in his capacity as acting chairman of the Hospitals Commission of New South Wales.

(3) The term of office as acting member of the Hospitals Commission of New South Wales of Walter Albert Edward Lewis, Esquire, is hereby extended to and shall expire upon the thirty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

Amendment of Act No. 8, 1929, s. 6 (5A).

(4) The Hospitals Act, 1929-1932, is amended by inserting at the end of subsection 5a of section six the following new paragraph:—

Where an acting chairman or an acting member vacates his office the Governor may appoint a person qualified under this section for appointment as acting chairman or acting member (as the case may be) to fill the vacant office. The appointment shall be made for the remainder of the unexpired term of the vacant office.
