PREVENTION AND RELIEF OF **UNEMPLOYMENT (AMENDMENT)** ACT.

Act No. 25, 1934.

An Act to extend the operation of Part II of George V, No. 25, 1934. the Prevention and Relief of Unemployment Acts, 1930–1932, as amended by subsequent [Assented to, 9th November, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prevention and Short title. Relief of Unemployment (Amendment) Act, 1934."

(2) The Prevention and Relief of Unemployment Acts, 1930-1932, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Prevention and Relief of Unemployment Act, 1930-1934.

2. The Prevention and Relief of Unemployment Acts. Amendment 1930-1932, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended of Act No. by omitting section eleven and by inserting in lieu thereof Substituted the following new section:—

11. (1) This Part of this Act shall, unless the Duration of operation thereof is extended under subsection two Part II of this section, cease to have effect on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.

(2) The Governor may, by proclamation made and published in the Gazette prior to the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, extend the operation of this Part of this Act for a period not exceeding four months in all after the said first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.
