An Act to extend the operation of Part II of George v. the Prevention and Relief of Unemployment No. 46, 1935. Act, 1930–1934. [Assented to, 31st October, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prevention and Short title Relief of Unemployment (Amendment) Act, 1935." and citation.
