PUBLIC SERVICE SALARIES (JUDGES) AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 57, 1935.

An Act to exclude from the provisions of the Public Service Salaries Act, 1931–1935, the Chief Justice and the puisne judges of the Supreme Court, the Judge of the Land and Valuation Court, the judges of the District Court and certain persons having the status of a Supreme Court judge or of a District Court judge; for this purpose to amend section three of the said Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 16th December, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Short title. Salaries (Judges) Amendment Act, 1935."

Amendment of Act No. 29, 1931, £.3. (Definition of officer.) ef. Act No. 21, 1930, £.2. 2. The Public Service Salaries Act, 1931-1935, is amended by inserting in the definition of the word "officer" in section three, after the words "the Private Secretary to His Excellency the Governor" the words—

"the Chief Justice and the puisne judges of the Supreme Court;

any member of any Commission having the status of a Supreme Court judge;

the Judge of the Land and Valuation Court;

any District Court judge or commissioner having the status of a District Court judge."
