An Act to extend the operation of Part II of the Edward VIII,
No. 45, 1936.
Prevention and Relief of Unemployment
Act, 1930-1935. [Assented to, 31st October,
1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prevention and Short title
and citation.

(2) The Prevention and Relief of Unemployment Act, 1930-1935, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prevention and Relief of Unemployment Act, 1930-1936."

Duration of
Act.

2. The Prevention and Relief of Unemployment Act, 1930-1935, is amended by omitting from section eleven the word "thirty-six" wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty-seven."
