

## PUBLIC HOSPITALS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 43, 1937.

An Act to provide for the addition to the Second Schedule of the Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1936, of the name of the Royal North Shore Hospital of Sydney and for the consequential repeal of the Royal North Shore Hospital of Sydney Act, 1910; to amend the Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1936, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 23rd December, 1937.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Hospitals (Amendment) Act, 1937." Short title  
and citation.

(2) The Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1937.

**2.** The Public Hospitals Act, 1929-1936, is amended— Amendment of  
Act No. 8, 1929.

(a) (i) by omitting from subsection three of section four the word "or" where secondly occurring; Sec. 4.

(ii) by inserting at the end of the same subsection the words "or the Royal North Shore Hospital of Sydney";

(iii) by inserting at the end of subsection six of the same section the following new paragraph:—
