

PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 61, 1941.

An Act to prohibit the promotion of or the taking part in certain shooting matches or competitions wherein animals are released from captivity for the purpose of shooting; to amend the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1901; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 25th November, 1941.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—
