Act No. 23, 1944.

An Act to relieve the Electoral Commissioner of George VI. the obligation of complying with Section No. 23, 1944. 120c of the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1944, in relation to certain elections; for this purpose to amend the said Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th November, 1944.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Short title. Electorates and Elections (Further Amendment) Act. 1944," and shall be read and construed with the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1944.
- 2.
