

**PARLIAMENTARY ELECTORATES AND
ELECTIONS (FURTHER AMENDMENT)
ACT.**

Act No. 23, 1944.

An Act to relieve the Electoral Commissioner of the obligation of complying with Section 120c of the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1944, in relation to certain elections; for this purpose to amend the said Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th November, 1944.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Electorates and Elections (Further Amendment) Act, 1944," and shall be read and construed with the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1944.

Short title.

2. The Electoral Commissioner shall be deemed to have been relieved of the obligation of complying with the requirements of section 120c of the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1944, in relation to each election specified in the Schedule to this Act.

Obligation imposed by sec. 120c of Act No. 41, 1912.
