## PARLIAMENTARY SELECT COMMITTEES ENABLING ACT.

## Act No. 18, 1948.

An Act to enable certain Parliamentary Select George VI. Committees to sit during the adjournment or prorogation of Parliament; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 21st May, 1948.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Short title. Select Committees Enabling Act, 1948."
- 2. It is hereby declared that the Parliamentary Select Certain Committees mentioned in the Schedule may lawfully sit Select Committees may during the period for which Parliament stands adjourned sit during or prorogued, and do all such things as they may or prorogalawfully do while Parliament is in session.
