

PRICES REGULATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 24, 1949.

An Act to amend the Prices Regulation Act, 1948, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 15th September, 1949.] George VI.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prices Regulation (Amendment) Act, 1949." Short title

(2) The Prices Regulation Act, 1948, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Prices Regulation Act, 1948-1949.
