

## PUBLIC SERVICE (AMENDMENT) ACT.

### Act No. 12, 1953.

An Act to amend section 13A of the Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 13th October, 1953.] Elizabeth II,  
No. 12, 1953.

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1953". Short title.

**2.** (1) The Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended— Amendment

- (a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection one of section 13A after the words "the provisions of" the words "subsection one of section sixty-six or the provisions of"; Sec. 13A.

- (b) by inserting in the same paragraph after the figures "1902" the words "as amended by subsequent Acts";
- (c) by inserting in paragraph (b) of the same subsection after the word "Act" the words "as so amended";
- (d) by omitting from the same subsection the words and figures "Superannuation Acts, 1916-1928" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures "Superannuation Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts";
- (e) by omitting subsections two and three of the same section.

**Ballina to Booyong Railway (Cessation of Operation) Act.****No. 12, 1953.**

(2) Where any pension to which an officer, who before the date on which this Act takes effect has retired from the Public Service under the provisions of subsection one of section sixty-six of the Public Service Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, is entitled under the Superannuation Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts, has not commenced before such date, such pension shall commence from such date.
