## PURE FOOD (AMENDMENT) ACT.

## Act No. 9, 1953.

Act to increase the penalties for certain offences under the Pure Food Act, 1908-1944; for this purpose to amend the said Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 25th September, 1953.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Pure Food (Amendment) Act, 1953".

(2) The Pure Food Act, 1908, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Pure Food Act, 1908-1953.

2. The Pure Food Act, 1908-1944, is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection one of section thirtysix the words "twenty pounds", "fifty pounds" 31, 1908. and "one hundred pounds" and by inserting in Sec. 36. lieu thereof the words "fifty pounds", "one (Penalty for offence hundred pounds" and "two hundred and fifty against this Act.) pounds" respectively;

(b) by omitting from subsection one of section fifty- Sec. 54. four the words "prescribing penalties not (Regulations made exceeding twenty pounds or a continuing on recom-penalty not exceeding two pounds per diem for mendation a contravention of any regulation; and 'and by committee.' inserting in lieu thereof the words "prescribing penalties not exceeding fifty pounds for the first offence, not exceeding one hundred pounds for the second offence and not exceeding two hundred and fifty pounds for any subsequent offence, and a continuing penalty not exceeding five pounds per diem, for a contravention of any provision of the regulations."
