

**PARLIAMENTARY ALLOWANCES AND SALARIES
(FURTHER AMENDMENT) ACT.**

Act No. 64, 1966.

An Act to make further provision with respect to the payment of an expense allowance to the Whip of a recognised political party in the Legislative Assembly; to amend the Parliamentary Allowances and Salaries Act, 1956, and certain other Acts; to validate certain matters; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 16th December, 1966.] **Elizabeth II,

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Allowances and Salaries (Further Amendment) Act, 1966". **Short title
and commencement**

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.

2. The Parliamentary Allowances and Salaries Act, 1956, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from paragraph (g) of subsection one of section five the words "referred to in paragraph (e) of this subsection" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "not less than ten members of which are members of the Legislative Assembly". **Amendment
