Act No. 68, 1967.

An Act to amend the Petroleum Act, 1955, as amended by subsequent Acts, consequentially upon the enactment of the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act, 1967; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 7th December, 1967.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Petroleum (Further Amendment) Act, 1967".

(2) This Act shall commence upon a day to be No. 68, 1967 appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

2. The Petroleum Act, 1955, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended— Amendment of Act No. 28, 1955.

- (a) by omitting subsection two of section three; Sec. 3.
(Interpretation.)
- (b) by inserting next after subsection two of section nine the following new subsection :— Sec. 9.
(Licences or leases may be granted.)
- (2A) A petroleum exploration licence or a petroleum mining lease shall not be granted under this Act in respect of any area within the adjacent area as defined in section four of the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act, 1967.
