Act No. 58, 1975.

An Act to amend the Public Transport Commission Act, 1972, to provide that the office of a nominated commissioner on the Public Transport Commission shall not be an office or place of profit under the Crown. [Assented to, 9th October, 1975.]

BE

Public Transport Commission (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Transport Commission (Amendment) Act, 1975".

2. The Public Transport Commission Act, 1972, is amended by inserting after section 7 (4) the following subsection :—

(4A) The office of a nominated commissioner shall, for the purposes of any Act, be deemed not to be an office or place of profit under the Crown.
