Act No. 6, 1975.

An Act to amend the Ambulance Service Act, 1972, so as to extend the term of office of members of the New South Wales Ambulance Board first constituted under that Act. [Assented to, 4th April, 1975.]

BE

Ambulance Service (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 6, 1975
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Ambulance Service Short title.
(Amendment) Act, 1975".

2. The Ambulance Service Act, 1972, is amended— Amendment

15, 1972.

(a) by omitting section 5 (4) and by inserting instead Sec. 5.
(Constitu-
tion of
Board.)
the following subsection:—

(4) The members holding office immediately
before the date of assent to the Ambulance Service
(Amendment) Act, 1975, shall, subject to this Act,
continue to hold office until the expiration of the
day which bears the date, 12th April, 1977, and
shall be eligible for re-appointment.

(b) by omitting from section 5 (5) the words "first
appointed under this Act" wherever occurring and
by inserting instead the words "referred to in
subsection (4)".
