Act No. 126, 1980.

An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and certain other Funds sums for the ordinary annual services of the Government for the year commencing on 1st July, 1980, and ending on 30th June, 1981, both dates inclusive, for charges supplementary or "Unauthorized in Suspense" from certain Funds for the year from 1st July, 1979, to 30th June, 1980, both dates inclusive, and for certain other purposes. [Assented to, 27th November, 1980.]

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

### PART IV.

#### GENERAL.

Variation of authorised expenditure from Consolidated Revenue Fund.

- 36. (1) Subject to section 34 of the Audit Act, 1902, and subsection (2), expenditure shall not be incurred on any item, subdivision, division or vote shown on the Estimates of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in excess of the sum provided therefore on those Estimates.
- (2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer or the person appointed by him may authorize the transfer of a specific amount from any item, subdivision or division other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services", to any other item, subdivision or division, within the same vote other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services".

Variation of Funds.

- 37. (1) Subject to subsection (2), expenditure shall not be incurred authorised expenditure on any division shown on the Estimates of the Maritime Services Board from other Fund and the Road Transport and Traffic Fund in excess of the sum provided therefore on those Estimates.
  - (2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer or the person appointed by him may authorize the transfer of a specific amount from any division, other than for specific public works, to any other division within the vote other than for specific public works.

- 38. (1) Nothing in sections 36 and 37 shall empower the Treasurer Provisions or the person appointed by him as referred to in those sections to authorize affecting the transfer of any sum in augmentation of or as an addition to any sections 36 and 37. salary or wages the amount of which has been fixed by law.
- (2) The Treasurer shall cause the Auditor-General to be informed of every authority granted pursuant to sections 36 and 37.
- 39. There shall be issued and paid any such sums referred to in Treasurer sections 36 and 37 for the purposes therein mentioned in such manner or lawful and in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant or order in authority writing under his hand and directed to the Treasurer or other lawful shall pay by warrant authority may from time to time order and direct, and the payments or order. so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the funds so referred to respectively; but the Treasurer shall not be held liable for any claims which may arise in connection with any of the State Departments transferred to the Commonwealth on or after the date of that transfer.

The Treasurer or other lawful authority shall in his or its respective Treasurer accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him or it in pursuance of a warrant or order in writing as referred to in section 39, and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the sum or sums is or are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the Treasurer or other lawful authority in passing those accounts for any such sum or sums as may be therein mentioned, and he or it shall receive credit for that sum or those sums accordingly.
