Act No. 62, 1991

An Act to make special provision regarding an appointment to the position of Inspector General in the Police Service. [Assented to 13 December 1991]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Police Service (Inspector General) Act 1991.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the date of assent.

Special appointment as Inspector General

- 3. (1) This Act applies to Mr Donald Keith Wilson who commenced duty in the Police Service on 29 July 1991.
- (2) Mr Wilson is taken for all purposes to have been duly appointed under the Police Service Act 1990 on 29 July 1991 to the position of Inspector General in the Police Service (being a position in the Police Service Senior Executive Service) for a period of 3 years commencing on that date.
- (3) This appointment is taken to have been effected by an instrument of appointment executed by the Governor on the recommendation of the Police Board and specifying that period as his term of office.
- (4) The appointment under this section has effect despite anything in the Police Service Act 1990.
