An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund sums for the recurrent services and capital works and services of the Government for the year 1992–93 and sums for supplementary charges and payments under section 22 of the Public Finance and Audit Act 1983 from the Consolidated Fund for the year 1991–92; and for certain other purposes. [Assented to 23 November 1992]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:**PART 1—PRELIMINARY****Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1992.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the date of assent.

Interpretation

3. In this Act:
 - (a) a reference to the year 1991–92 is a reference to the year from 1 July 1991 to 30 June 1992; and
 - (b) a reference to the year 1992–93 is a reference to the year from 1 July 1992 to 30 June 1993.

4 (1) Out of the Consolidated Fund there are hereby appropriated the sums identified in sections 6 to 27, inclusive, as the sums appropriated by this Act for recurrent services, which sums may be issued and applied for or towards the several uses and purposes expressed in those sections for the ordinary annual services of the Government for the year 1992–93.

(2) The total sum appropriated out of the Consolidated Fund for the ordinary annual services of the Government for the year 1992–93, in accordance with the provisions of sections 6 to 27, inclusive, is the sum of \$15,700,751,000.

(3) Any amounts expended for recurrent services under section 25 of the Public Finance and Audit Act 1983 or any Supply Act on or after 1 July 1992 and before the date of assent to this Act are taken to have been expended out of such of the sums for recurrent services set out in sections 6 to 27, inclusive, as may be determined by the Treasurer.

General appropriation from Consolidated Fund 1992–93 for capital works and services

5. (1) Out of the Consolidated Fund there are hereby appropriated the sums identified in sections 6 to 27, inclusive, as the sums appropriated by this Act for capital works and services, which sums may be issued and applied for or towards the several uses and purposes expressed in those sections for the capital works and services for the year 1992–93.

(2) The total sum appropriated out of the Consolidated Fund for the capital works and services for the year 1992–93, in accordance with the provisions of sections 6 to 27, inclusive, is the sum of \$4,950,398,000.

(3) Any amounts expended for capital works and services under section 25 of the Public Finance and Audit Act 1983 or any Supply Act on or after 1 July 1992 and before the date of assent to this Act are taken to have been expended out of such of the sums for capital works and services set out in sections 6 to 27, inclusive, as may be determined by the Treasurer.

30. (1) Payment of the sums appropriated under sections 6 to 27, inclusive, may not be made on a program shown in the Budget Paper

entitled "Budget Estimates 1992–93" in excess of the sums provided in that Budget Paper for the program, except as provided by this section and Division 4 of Part 2 of the Public Finance and Audit Act 1983.

(2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Minister for Finance may authorise:

- (a) the payment of a sum in excess of the amount shown in the Budget Paper entitled "Budget Estimates 1992–93" as the Consolidated Fund Recurrent Payments estimate for a program, but only on the condition that an equivalent sum is not paid out of the estimate of the Consolidated Fund Recurrent Payments for another program; and
- (b) the payment of a sum in excess of the amount shown in that Budget Paper as the Consolidated Fund Capital Payments estimate for a program, but only on the condition that an equivalent sum is not paid out of the estimate of the Consolidated Fund Capital Payments for another program.

(3) This section does not apply to sums appropriated otherwise than by this Act.

(4) This section does not empower the Minister for Finance to authorise the payment of a sum in augmentation of or as an addition to any salary or wages the amount of which has been fixed by law.

(5) The Minister for Finance is required to inform the Auditor-General of every authorisation given under this section.

Appointment of person to carry out the functions of the Minister for Finance under section 30

31. (1) The Minister for Finance may appoint a person to carry out the functions of the Minister for Finance under section 30.

(2) Any such appointment is subject to such conditions (if any) as the Minister for Finance determines.

(3) The Minister for Finance may revoke any such appointment at any time.
