An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund sums for the recurrent services and capital works and services of the Government for the year 1996–97. [Assented to 28 June 1996]

## The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

## Part 1 Preliminary

## 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Appropriation Act 1996.

## 2 Commencement

This Act commences on 1 July 1996.

## 3 Interpretation

In this Act:

- (a) a reference to the year 1995–96 is a reference to the year from 1 July 1995 to 30 June 1996, and
- (b) a reference to the year 1996–97 is a reference to the year from 1 July 1996 to 30 June 1997.

# Part 2 Appropriations out of the Consolidated Fund

## 4 General appropriation from Consolidated Fund 1996–97 for recurrent services

- (1) Out of the Consolidated Fund there are hereby appropriated the sums identified in sections 6 to 25, inclusive, as the sums appropriated by this Act for recurrent services, which sums may be issued and applied for or towards the several uses and purposes expressed in those sections for the ordinary annual services of the Government for the year 1996–97.
- (2) The total sum appropriated out of the Consolidated Fund for the ordinary annual services of the Government for the year 1996–97, in accordance with the provisions of sections 6 to 25, inclusive, is the sum of \$20,333,106,000.
- (3) Any amounts expended for recurrent services under section 25 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983* or any Supply Act on or after 1 July 1996 and before the date of assent to this Act are taken to have been expended out of such of the sums for recurrent services set out in sections 6 to 25, inclusive, as may be determined by the Treasurer.

## 5 General appropriation from Consolidated Fund 1996–97 for capital works and services

- (1) Out of the Consolidated Fund there are hereby appropriated the sums identified in sections 6 to 25, inclusive, as the sums appropriated by this Act for capital works and services, which sums may be issued and applied for or towards the several uses and purposes expressed in those sections for the capital works and services for the year 1996–97.
- (2) The total sum appropriated out of the Consolidated Fund for the capital works and services for the year 1996–97, in accordance with the provisions of sections 6 to 25, inclusive, is the sum of \$3,142,294,000.

(3) Any amounts expended for capital works and services under section 25 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act I983* or any Supply Act on or after 1 July 1996 and before the date of assent to this Act are taken to have been expended out of such of the sums for capital works and services set out in sections 6 to 25, inclusive, as may be determined by the Treasurer.

## Part 3 General

### 26 Variation of authorised payments from Consolidated Fund

- (1) Payment of the sums appropriated under this Act may not be made on a program shown in the Budget Paper entitled *Budget Estimates 1996*–97 in excess of the sums provided in that Budget Paper for the program, except as provided by this section and Division 4 of Part 2 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*.
- (2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer may authorise:
  - (a) the payment of a sum in excess of the amount shown in the Budget Paper entitled *Budget Estimates 1996–97* as the Consolidated Fund Recurrent Payments estimate for a program, but only on the condition that an equivalent sum is not paid out of the estimate of the Consolidated Fund Recurrent Payments for another program, and
  - (b) the payment of a sum in excess of the amount shown in that Budget Paper as the Consolidated Fund Capital Payments estimate for a program, but only on the condition that an equivalent sum is not paid out of the estimate of the Consolidated Fund Capital Payments for another program.
- (3) This section does not apply to sums appropriated otherwise than by this Act.
- (4) This section does not empower the Treasurer to authorise the payment of a sum in augmentation of or as an addition to any salary or wages the amount of which has been fixed by law.
- (5) The Treasurer, or a person appointed by the Treasurer under section 27, is required to inform the Auditor-General of every authorisation given under this section.

General Part 3

# 27 Appointment of person to carry out the functions of the Treasurer under section 26

- (1) The Treasurer may appoint a person to carry out the Treasurer's functions under section 26.
- (2) Any such appointment is subject to such conditions (if any) as the Treasurer determines.
- (3) The Treasurer may revoke any such appointment at any time.
