Constitution Amendment (Appointment of Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator) Act 2022 No 56

Act No 56, 2022

An Act to amend the *Constitution Act 1902* to clarify that the appointment of persons to the offices of Lieutenant-Governor of the State and Administrator of the State is to be made by the Governor of the State. [Assented to 26 October 2022]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts—

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Constitution Amendment (Appointment of Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator) Act 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.

(1) Section 9B Appointment of Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator
