A BILL

To amend the Aborigines Protection Act, 1909.

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Aborigines Protec-Short title. tion (Amendment) Act, 1916.

2. Section three of the Aborigines Protection Act, Amendment 1909, is amended by omitting the definition of ^{of s. 3.} Definition of "Aborigine" and inserting the following definition in "Aborigine." lieu thereof :—

"Aborigine" means-

- (a) any full-blooded aboriginal native of Australia, and
- (b) any person whose father or mother is a fullblooded native of Australia,

who applies for or is in receipt of rations or aid from the board or is residing on a reserve.

3. The following section is inserted next after section. New section. nineteen :--

19A. Any person who seeks as an aborigine to Onus of proof take advantage of any provision of this Act shall ^{of being an} aborigine. "aborigine" within the meaning of this Act.
