A BILL

To amend the Apiaries Act, 1916, and the
Apiaries (Amendment) Act, 1917.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the " Apiaries (Amend- Short title.
ment) Act, 1923."

2. Section twelve of the Apiaries Act, 1916, as inserted by section four of the Apiaries (Amendment) Act, 1917, is omitted, and the following section is inserted in lieu thereof:—

12. (1) Every beekeeper shall register his apiary in such manner and at such times as may be prescribed. Every application for such registration shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee.

Registration

(2) A beekeeper who removes his apiary shall within fourteen days of such removal give notice thereof in the manner and form prescribed.

(3) A beekeeper who fails to comply with any of the provisions of this section shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding *twenty* pounds.
